## Lesson Plan: La France vend des armes.

## Learning objectives:

- -To learn how to discuss and express views/empathy about war and exploitation
- -To learn some facts about arms sales from France to Africa
- -To learn how to understand and express emotions in French about such themes

Slide	Activity	Timings
1-3	Pre-reading. Pupils guess what the topic of the text might be from pictures and what emotions might be evoked. Check using slide 3.	5 mins
4	Presentation of key vocabulary to enable pupils to access text.	3 mins
5-7	Read the text to class [full text appears on Slide 11]. Slide 6 has mixed up paragraphs of text for pupils to put in order. Correct using slide 7. Feedback as a class.	6 mins
8-10	Pupils complete gap fill activity on second listening. Answers on slide 10. Optional translation work on any problematic phrases/words.	6 mins
11-12	Pupils match paragraphs with summaries. Answers on slide 12	5 mins
13-14	True/ False comprehension questions about article to help pupils understand situation and to help them appreciate the theme of exploitation/war/profit (there is some use of irony in the text – you might want to discuss this in English). In pairs then correct as class.	5 mins
15	Pupils identify and underline facts and the authors' feelings/opinions in the text. They can note these down if they don't have a hard copy of the text.	8 mins
16 - 17	Pupils evaluate the tone of the article, based on the previous activity, then identify the feelings which this article evokes for them (slide 17).	5 mins
18	Pupils choose the picture which best sums up the article, giving reasons if possible.	5 mins
19-20	Read the text again to them, with some emotion. Pupils note down for each paragraph how the child might feel. Take some feedback.	8 mins
21-23	Explain homework. Option 1: To make a recording, expression emotion (scaffolded, slide 22). Option 2: Write a letter to the president of France from the perspective of a young soldier (scaffolded, slide 23).	4 mins
